#### 1.2 Chairman's report

**EL** reported on behalf of **PL** that the nature reserve was in a healthy state and being managed well. The long awaited capping and landing area works at the southern end of the lake were completed in early spring. The effectiveness and quality of the work was commendable. The coppicing programme continued at various times throughout the year and was very effective in promoting reed growth and generally improving the appearance and health of the nature reserve. It is hoped that the terracing area project at the northern end of the lake will be undertaken during 2016 and that progress will be made towards the establishment of a themed, children's playground in an area of the car park. Eight cygnets

hatched in May were all still alive and thriving at the end of the year. This is the best survival rate anyone can remember.

It was concluded that the Forum had successfully performed its role and duties throughout the past year, remained financially solvent and was well placed to continue to manage effectively its responsibilities with respect to the Swanpool nature reserve.

### **1.3 Treasurer's report**

The Treasurer (**MB**) was unable to attend the meeting but had made available reports to show that the Forum's bank balance currently stood at £1955 and that there were no outstanding financial liabilities. (Balance at last AGM = £1822)

**2.6 Charity status update.**

EL explained the background to this initiative. Progress on establishing charity status for the Forum has slowed following personnel changes at CRCC (Cornwall Rural Community Charity), the organisation which first recommended the charity status initiative. EL has requested clarification on a number of points, including confirmation that CRCC still supports the original recommendation to register Swanpool Forum as a CIO (charitable incorporated organisation).
